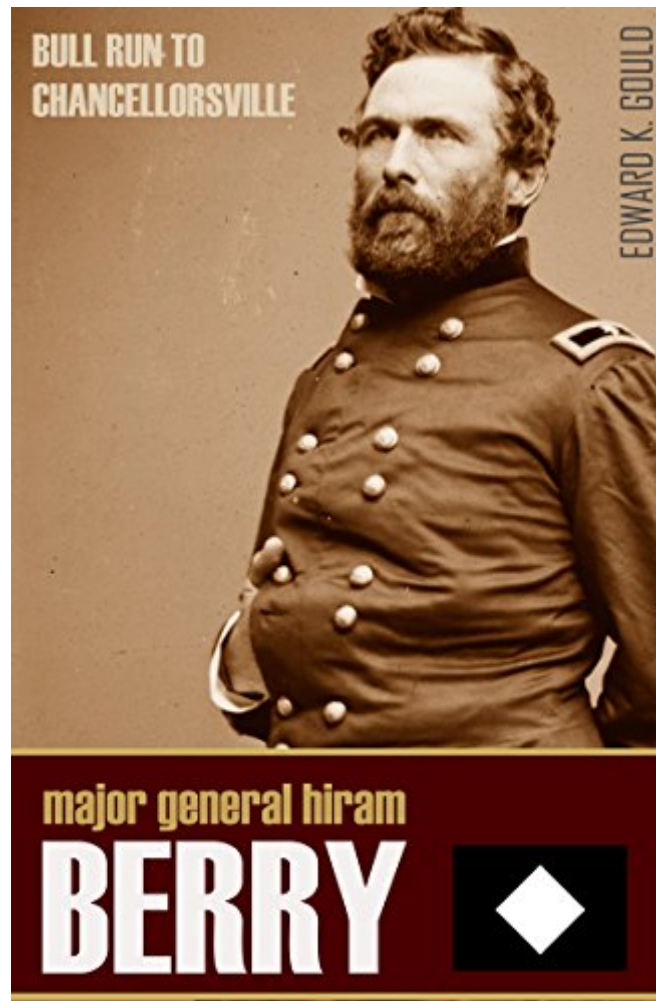


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Major-General Hiram G. Berry: Bull Run To Chancellorsville (Abridged, Annotated)
