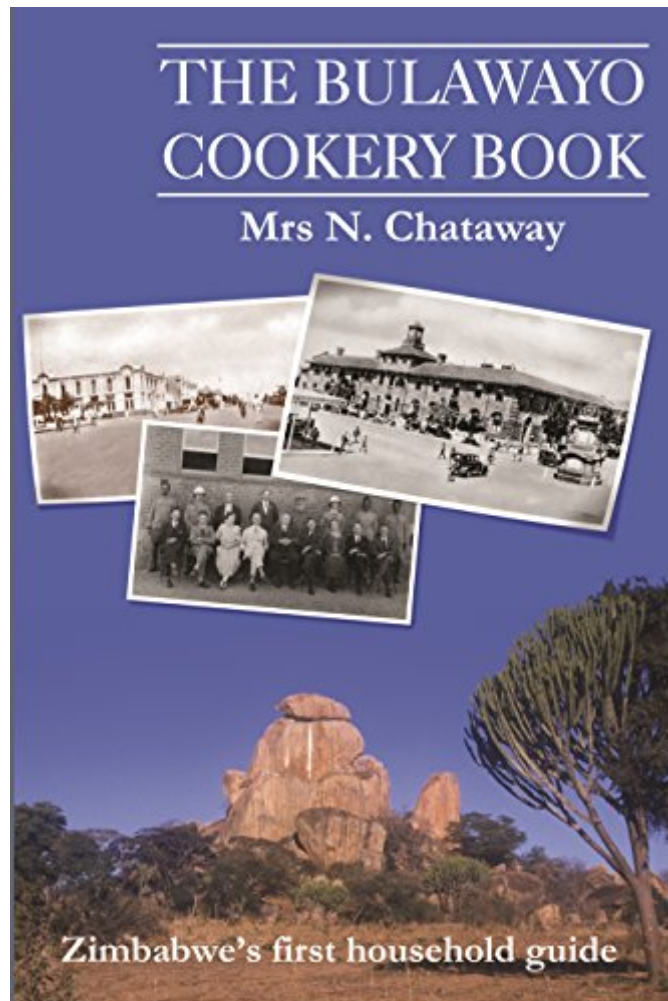


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The Bulawayo Cookery Book: Zimbabwe's Original 1909 Cookery Book
